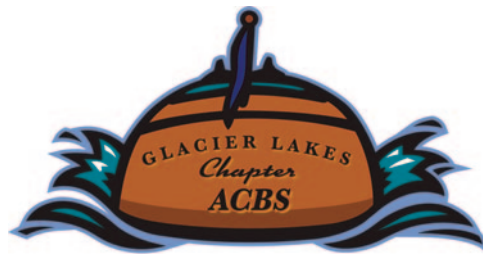

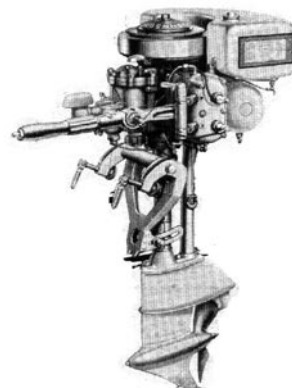

Dear MACBS Participants:

Welcome to the 2020 Minocqua Antique & Classic Boat Show (MACBS) and to the famed Minocqua Chain of Lakes. My name is Marc Toigo and, with the help of my wife Lynn, many sponsors, and volunteers, I am the Event Director of the 2020 MACBS. Special thanks go out all the show founders, Al Hanley, and all the participants over the past 28 years.

This year we are going to hold the show over two (2) days, Friday and Saturday, June 26 & 27th 2020. This is going to be a busy weekend in the area so be sure to reserve hotel space immediately. In 2020, there is only one weekend between Fathers Day and July 4th and we are having the 2020 MACBS on that Friday and Saturday. 1957 SwitzerCraft Shooting Star. I hope you will see all three of these at the show this year.

Our participants and guests share a passion for vintage boats of all types and manufacturers. I am sure you will agree that the reward comes through the smiling faces of our guests as they enjoy each of the boats displayed. 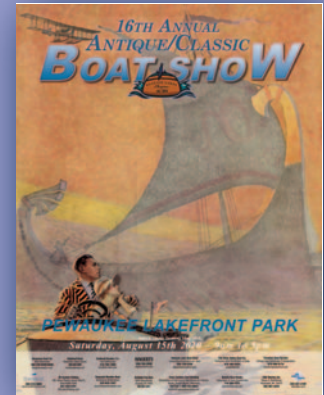

1959 Thompson "Old Pal"



My name is Gene O'Kelly, age 76 and this is my first classic old wood boat restoration project. I live in New Berlin, WI. I have been doing other old boat project fixer uppers for sixty years in the pursuit of the perfect fishing boat for me. My first boat was a galvanized tin Lizzy. Then I had a Thompson Wood boat that I gutted and transformed into a bass boat. I just loved it until it dry rotted to death. Next, I bought a fiberglass decked run-a-bout that I gutted and transformed into a bass boat. It turned out to be a little too small. Then I got a free fiberglass tri hull from a junk yard that I repaired the broken transom plus a hole in the hull. After cutting out all the molded front wrap around seating, and windshields, it fished very nicely, but I couldn't make it pretty enough to suit me. After a series of these old boats, my wife and kids would just roll their eyes every time I started a new project. Later when I bought a brand-new boat my wife called the kids to tell them about it. She was greeted with a long silence. After a bit they asked for clarification. "From a boat store" – they didn't believe it. Over the winter I have been writing a story called "Me and My Boats" that has some adventure and funny events associated with each of them.

One day as I was helping a daughter remodel her old house, she pointed out that there was an old boat for sale across the street. She knew I loved old wood boats, and even though I had sort of vowed to myself "no more boat projects", I had to go look at it. There it was, a 1959 wood Thompson run a bout. The owner had inherited it from his father and had intended to restore it, but never got around to it. It was peeling varnish, sun bleached, and full of debris, dirt and leaves. Sad looking, but pretty solid, I thought it would be a fun project to restore. Maybe I could do "one more boat project" and strike a blow at mortality. Too bad us old guys can't be restored too. I started on it in the spring of 2019 and hope to finish it up during the summer of 2020 and perhaps put it in a few shows. It is a lot of work but it's looking pretty sharp already. I decided to name it "Old Pal", and it will have some antique fishing décor as well. I found a working 60's era Evinrude Big Twin Outboard that needs a little refurbishing too, but will complete the package.
