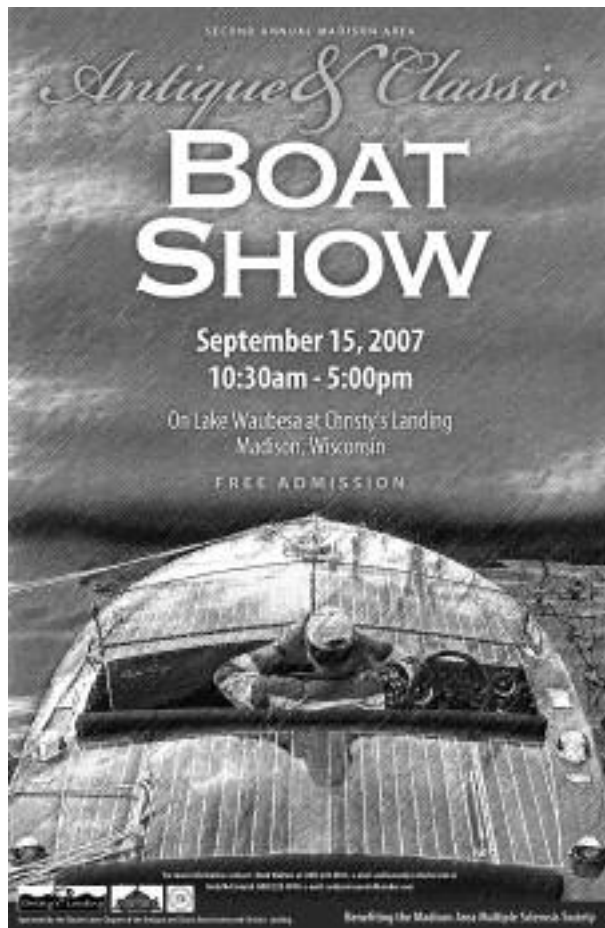

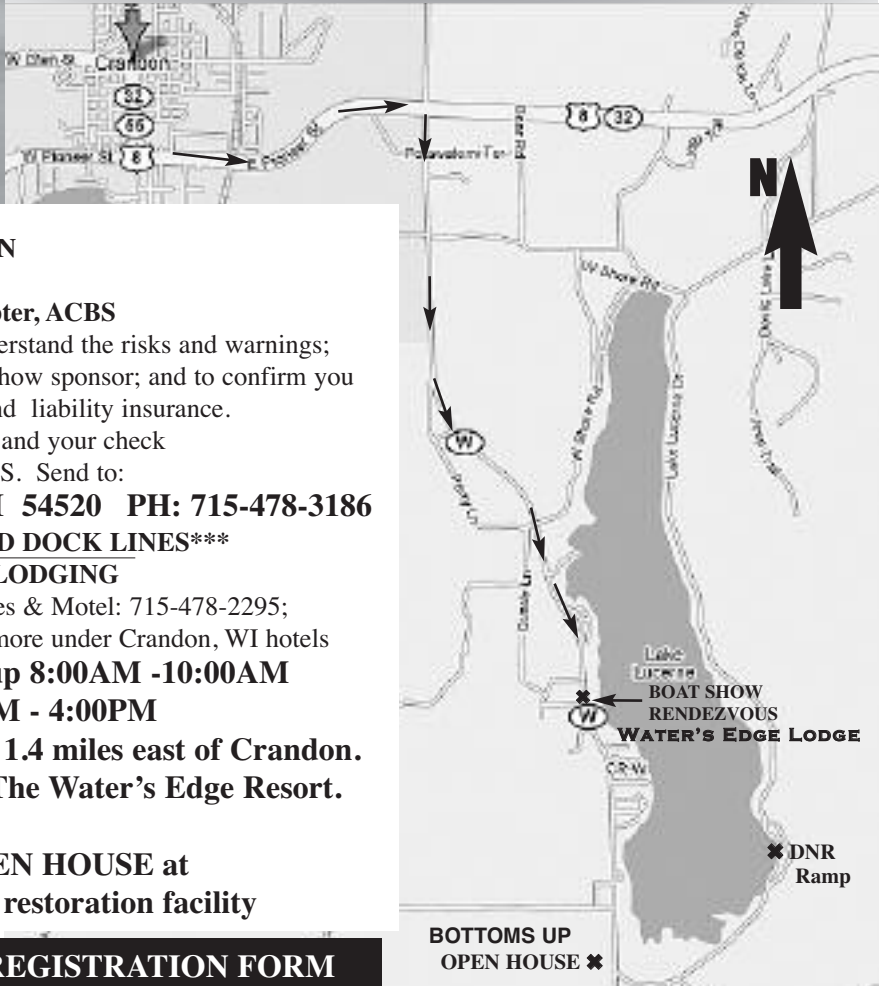

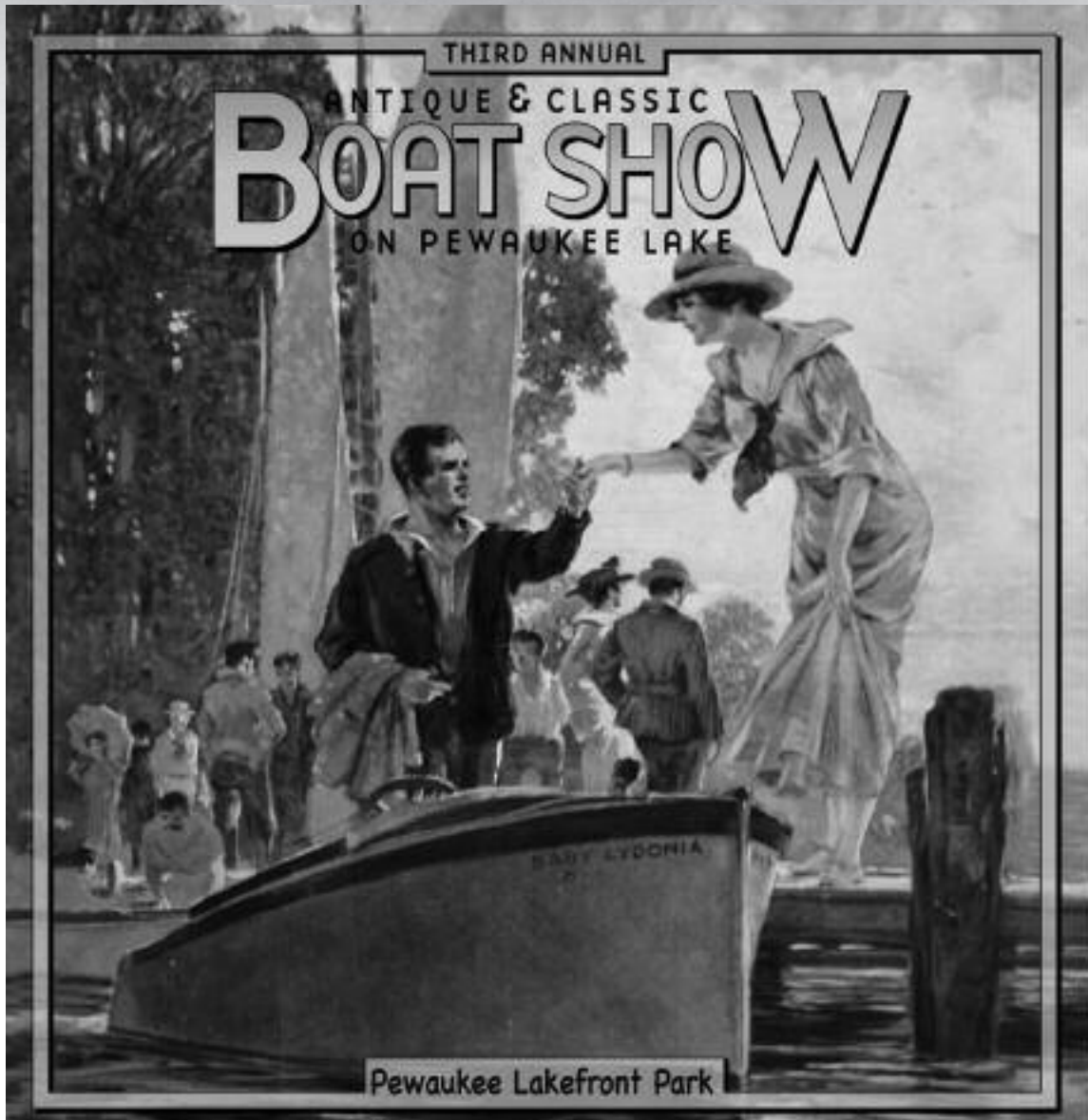

GENEVA LAKES 2007 SCHEDULE OF EVENTS DESCRIPTION

NEW EVENTS FOR FRIDAY ! We'll board the steam-powered Louise(1902), an all-weather historic day launch and arrive at Black Point Mansion for a private tour. Built in 1888 in the Queen Ann style, the museum has 13 bedrooms and features a 4 story crows nest, which served as an observation tower to the panoramic views of Geneva Lake. This private viewing is available via this launch only. The property is on 6 acres with 600 feet of shoreline, with a fair amount of steep steps up to the Mansion. 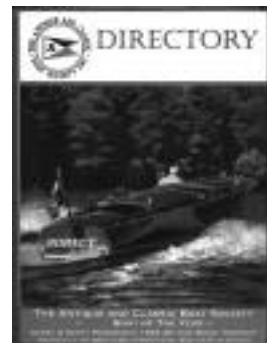
